Mature in Christ

All the Gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John, record the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on what we today call Palm Sunday. His followers acquired a colt of a donkey for him to ride and throngs of people were shouting praises to God while lying their cloaks and palm branches in the street so the young donkey would not have to step on the ground while carrying the King.

Jerusalem and her people had found their new King. No longer would God's chosen people suffer under the iron fist of the Roman Empire. They would be liberated, set free. Free to rule themselves, free to make their own national decisions, free to live as they had so desperately hoped for so many years. However, the Israelites were very temporal in the view.

They were sure Jesus was going to change everything for them immediately here on Earth and they grew rapidly discontent as they discovered this was not the case.

Within less than a week, the crowds had turned from singing praises and worshiping God for the sent Messiah to shouting at Jesus, spitting on him, and wanting him cruci-

fied.

In considering the actions of the Israelites, we think how could they have been so wrong, how could they have been so immature in their thinking? It's easy! As infants in Christ we are tossed back and forth from doctrine to suggestion and from solid rock to sinking sand. The only way to avoid this is to gain understanding and become mature in Christ.



first. "The fact that we are in the minority and falsely accused of hate and bigotry should not change how we respond. We are still to speak the truth in love. We are still to pray for our enemies. We are still to overcome evil with good. Jesus' words in the Sermon on the Mount are our best encouragement: "Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for, in the same way, they persecuted the prophets who were before you" (Matthew 5:11-12).

Destined to win, Larry Snavely 13 until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ. 14 Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. 15 Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ.

Being immature in Christ is dangerous. We will be blown by any wind of change and get caught up in deceitful ways. The only way to avoid it is to do what is clearly stated in verse 13 above "until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ".

Are you mature in Christ? How many souls have you set on the path to salvation in Christ? These are important questions. Ask God to show you the answers and be prepared to make changes in your life so "we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ".
