In 1939. when most German ministers had been intimidated into silence, Dietrich Bonhoeffer openly expressed opposition to the policies of Adolph Hitler. When a

radio broadcast of one of his sermons was cut off in midsentence.

Bonhoeffer knew he was in serious danger. He those whom God fled to America, where he was invited to speak in some of the leading pulpits of the Western world.
