

Robert Morgan's book *Calm Your Anxiety* highlights the difference between happiness and joy.

"Happiness is an emotion. Joy is an attitude. We can't always control our emotions, but we can control our attitude. Every day we awake, we can say with the Psalmist, 'This is the day the Lord has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it'" (<u>Psalm 118:24 CSB</u>).

That is why the Apostle Paul could be joyful even while in prison.

Jesus was joyful. His assignment of dying on the cross certainly didn't bring happiness, but <u>Hebrews 12:2</u> <u>-3</u> teaches, "...fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him, he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider him who

endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart."

Even in the shadow of the cross, Jesus encouraged His followers: *"I've told you these things for a purpose: that my joy might be your joy, and your joy wholly ma-ture"* (John 15:11).

When we are grumpy and melancholy, we alienate others, make ourselves miserable, and waste the precious present. When we make a daily choice to be joyful, we live each day to the fullest, are more fun to live with, and are a much better witness for Jesus Christ. So, choose joy!




